

First River Vista residents just weeks from moving in

The first residents at the River Vista Apartments in downtown Wichita are expected to move in sometime next month.

Amy Liebau, spokeswoman for developer George Laham's Laham Development company, said Wednesday that the first residents in the complex's 80-unit north building are expected to move in before the end of April.

The riverside complex, Liebau said, is still on track to be completed in June. It sits just east of the new Advanced Learning Library along McLean Boulevard.

All apartments in the complex, which will feature more than 200 units when complete, will feature views of the river and either the downtown skyline or the Keeper of the Plains.
